## Brothers raised on punk and skateboards get their first Cali museum gig

The frenzied, color-saturated art of Rob and Christian Clayton inspires drug similes: Red Grooms on acid, Arcimboldo on speed, Lari Pittman on Advil. Yet the two tattooed brothers cocreate paintings like Joy Jelly Jump Junk (detail above) and installations in small-town La Crescenta. "Our door's always open." says Christian. Now museum doors are opening as the Pasadena Museum of California Art presents Clayton Brothers: Inside Out. One high point recalls an urban Laundromat. Their next inspiration?
