Remembering the Golden Age of American Economic Dominance, a handcrafted paper flag layered with acrylic and gold leaf, is a stunning statement on capitalism and financial turmoil from Mission artist Andrew Schoultz. "I started thinking about flags after a conversation with my dad about Asia. The American flag is a symbol of pride in our country, and yet so many U.S. flags today are produced in China," says Schoultz. "My flag represents the irony in that. The gilding represents our economy, which is backed by gold, even though there's not enough gold on the planet to back the states."
