

Mark Moore Gallery is pleased to announce a four-person group show featuring Martin Durazo, David French, John Lyon, and Steve Peirce.

Deconstructing recognizable objects from daily life, Durazo, French, Lyon, and Peirce present the viewer with a myriad of contradictions and alternate interpretations of the world in which we live through painting, sculpture and installation. The canvases of John Lyon and Steve Peirce employ patterns and theatrics that explore the ground between abstraction and figuration. David French's sculptures offer a post-modern interpretation of minimalist sculpture by using Styrofoam and cameleon paint, used in the manufacturing of automobiles, as primary materials. Durazo's large-scale installations, constructed from a compilation of found objects such as tables, plants and photographs challenge the viewer's perceptions of everyday objects and how we interact with them.
