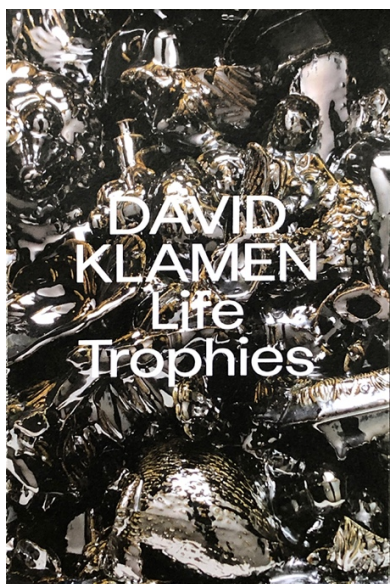

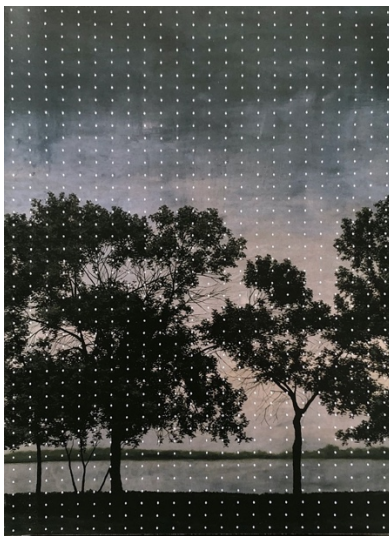

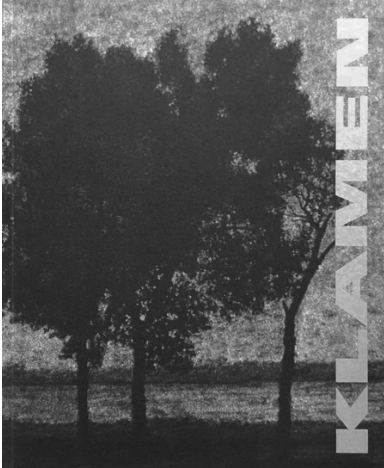


"David Klamen: Painting Paintings," Text by Lisa Wainwright, 17 pages, Richard Gray Gallery, Chicago / New York 2010

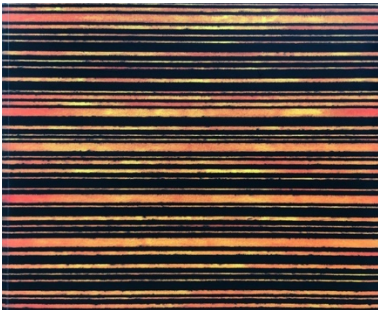

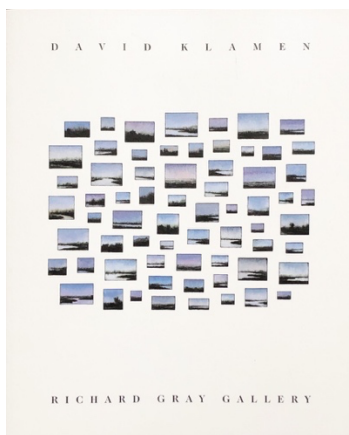

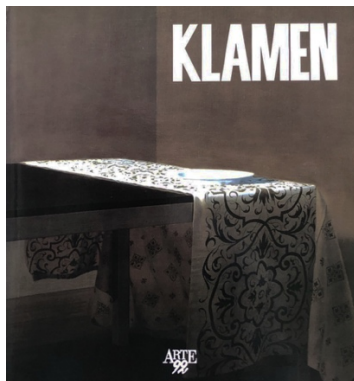

"David Klamen," Text by Kathryn Hixson, 37 pages, Haines Gallery, San Francisco, 2000

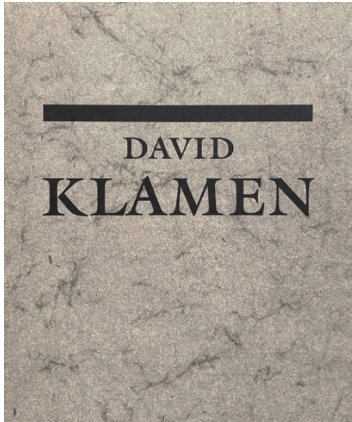


"Index, Icon, Horizon: David Klamen," 7 pages, Richard Gray Gallery, Chicago / New York, Text by Timothy Van Laar 1998

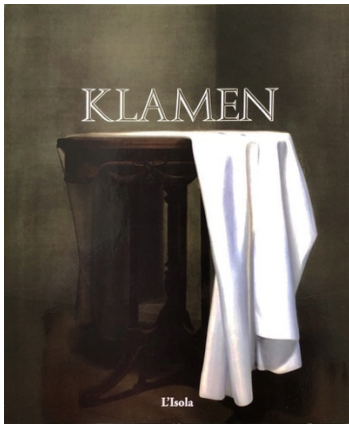


"Klamen," Text by Kathryn Hixson, 48 pages, Arte 92, Milan, Italy 1998

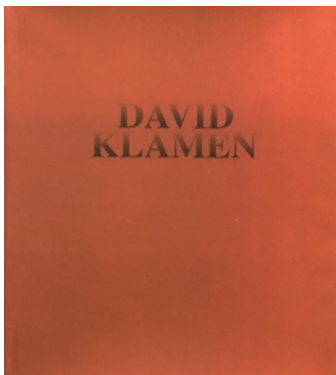

"*David Klamen: Paintings*," Text by Kathryn Hixson, 28 pages, Richard Gray Gallery, Chicago / New York 1996

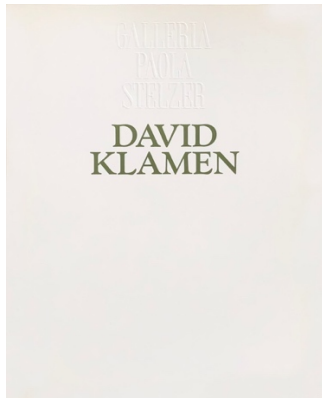


"*Klamen*," Text by Carlo Battaglia, 32 pages, Galleria L'Isola, Rome, Italy 1995

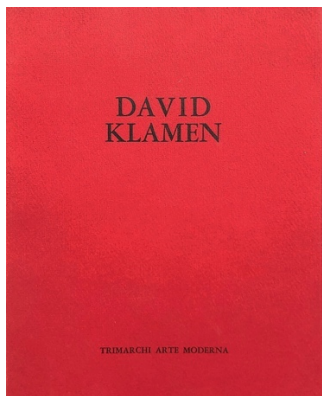


"*David Klamen*," Text by Ludovico Pratesi, 54 pages, Galleria L'Isola, Rome, Italy 1991

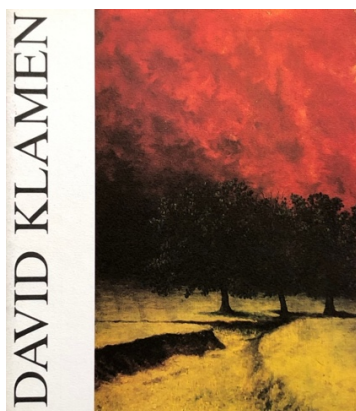
